



OUR LOCAL VINEYARDS

Nearly all South African wine comes from the Western Cape, where Old and New World winemaking blend with a warm climate and ancient granite soils to produce bold wines with high aromatic intensity. Recognising the Cape's unique terroir, and with no indigenous wine grapes, the first grapevines arrived by way of the Dutch East India Company in the mid-1600s.

On 2 February 1659, the first grapes for winemaking were planted, a stone's throw from our Bistro, at Jan van Riebeeck's farm, Bosheuvel, on the slopes of Wynberg Hill. In 1685, Simon van der Stel, the first Governor of the Dutch Cape Colony established a vast property, encompassing almost the entire valley, and named it "Constantia". On his death, in 1712, the estate was auctioned off as three separate lots, one more suitable for livestock and the two remaining as wine farms (Groot Constantia and Klein Constantia). By the mid-1700s, the dessert wine, Constantia, was famous across Europe, but then around the 1870s, it vanished into myth. In the 1990s, Klein Constantia resurrected this iconic sweet wine, following the old recipe, and the Vin de Constance became legendary once more.

Over the last few decades, the Constantia Wine Route has seen a remarkable fusion of heritage renewal and innovative growth. From conservation-led viticulture and integrated pest management to shared "Constantia" bottles and a wave of boutique newcomers like Beau Constantia, Constantia Glen, Eagle's Nest, High Constantia and Nova Zonnestraal. This synergy of preservation in the cooler Constantia Ward, innovation, terroir-focus, and community resilience defines Constantia's vibrant wine-farm landscape today.

With such an illustrious local history, our wine list pays homage to the best that Constantia has to offer. Whether you're after a crisp, refreshing white or a rich, velvety red your palate will be met with a refined balance of flavour and finesse.

WADE BALES “BRUT ROSÉ” (2024)

Ripe red berry notes with a hint of spice are beautifully balanced by a luxurious texture and an elegant mousse, leading to a light-bodied palate with a lingering, dry finish.

KLEIN CONSTANTIA “BLANC DE BLANC” (2020)

Grown in a single block and harvested at different times to capture varying flavours and complexity, this wine is crafted from free-run juice, aged in steel barrels for seven months before spending a further 38 months in bottle. On the nose, it reveals aromas of green apple and stone fruit, while the palate shows ripe citrus layered with hints of tropical fruits. Soft yet bold, with a mousse-like texture and a vibrant acidity, it finishes ripe and expressive, enhanced by its zero-dosage style.

STEENBERG “CHARDONNAY”

The 1682 Brut Chardonnay has a pale lemon colour and a delicate mousse. It exudes freshness and pure fruit on the nose, vibrant notes of Granny Smith apple, candied lemon rind and white peach. It is lively on the palate, displaying finesse and complexity with a crisp acidity. Flavours of lemon cordial, honeyed nectarines, toasted croissant and pistachio are evident on the palate. It has a long, yet refreshing finish.

HIGH CONSTANTIA “CLOS ANDRE” (2021) R690

Made exclusively from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, this wine has a delicate yet robust texture, lifted by high acidity and lively carbonation.

HIGH CONSTANTIA “CLOS ANDRE” (2007) R1500

This exceptional MCC, a blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier, is aged for 12.5 years on the lees with zero dosage and “zero” sulphur content. It recalls the 2021 vintage but with softer tannins, flinty notes, and hints of raisin, alongside vibrant citrus, grapefruit, lemon, and focused tree fruit flavors of apple and apricot, complemented by creamy, bready, and yeasty nuances. The texture is delicate yet robust, with bright acidity, lively fizz, and a lingering creamy mouthfeel, earning its place as one of the MCCs of all time.

BEAU CONSTANTIA “PAS DE NOM NON R650 VINTAGE” (2025)

A Methode Cap Classique made from 100% Chardonnay grapes grown on the cool, sandstone mid-slopes of Franschoek. This MCC boasts a lively, fine mousse and zesty, citrus aromas that demand a plunge into the sparkling medium. Beyond the first aromas one experiences a fleeting aroma of brioche before the Olfactory cortex becomes completely consumed by flavours of green apple and limestone. The palate shows rich texture, though light in weight, with a beautifully balanced acidity.

STEENBERG “LADY R” VINTAGE BRUT (2020) R1 350

A sparkling expression of Constantia’s cool elegance. Fine, persistent bubbles reveal layers of brioche, citrus zest, and roasted almond. The palate is poised and creamy, with bright acidity and a finish that lingers in graceful balance.



SAUVIGNON BLANC

In Constantia, Sauvignon Blanc occupies 188 hectares, representing nearly 45% of the total hectares under vine in the region. This makes it the most popular grape variety planted in Constantia. The total area under vine in Constantia is around 437 hectares.

WADE BALES (2025) R220 R85

Fresh tropical fruit scents and cut grass undertones. The palate is fresh and mouth-watering with well-balanced acidity.

STEENBERG NON VINTAGE R260 R100

Vibrant and mineral-driven, with aromas of lime leaf, elderflower, and passionfruit. Crisp citrus and gooseberry glide across a saline finish — a pure, refreshing reflection of Constantia's maritime terroir.

CONSTANTIA GLEN (2023) R240

Intense varietal character is the cornerstone of our classically-styled Sauvignon Blanc, combining tropical fruit flavours with a well-integrated minerality. A wine of freshness, impeccable balance and great length.

BUITENVERWACHTING “HUSSEYS VLEI” (2022) R300

The wine has a pale lemon-yellow colour and a bouquet reminiscent of green peppers combined with herbaceous aromas. The wine is dry, full bodied and has a long lingering finish.

HIGH CONSTANTIA (2024) R270

With bold fruit notes of apple and lemon, and a subtle hint of herb on the finish, this wine is medium-bodied with medium-high acidity and a depth of character that lingers on the palate.

KLEIN CONSTANTIA “CLARA” (2023) R550

Intense varietal character is the cornerstone of our classically-styled Sauvignon Blanc, combining tropical fruit flavours with a well-integrated minerality. A wine of freshness, impeccable balance and great length.

HIGH CONSTANTIA “CIELO NEL CAPO” (2021) R390

This small vineyard, steep and difficult mountain slopes, hand worked, 1400 bottles produced, 10 months in French Acacia and Oak wood, lime zest, melon and grapefruit driven.

CONSTANTIA ROYALE (2023) R220

This wine is an elegant, concentrated Sauvignon Blanc, poised between ripe tropical summer flavours, and a green, mineral herbaceousness. The acidity is perfectly balanced, and the wine is made to be drunk within 1 to 3 years after bottling.

STEENBERG (2024)

R350

Our 2024 Semillon is a beautiful pale gold colour. Aromas of cinnamon and dried apricot and orange blossom greet you upon first inspection. The palate shares much the same fruit profile as the nose though now with distinct custard and vanilla pod characteristics.

CHENIN BLANC

BUITENVERWACHTING “PIONEER” (2024)

The small tight golden bunches giving crisp natural acidity and immense concentration. Hints of yellow fruit and some fynbos/tea-leaf characters, with a long elegant finish.

VIOGNIER

BEAU CONSTANTIA “CECILY” (2024)

R450

Viognier, a rare grape variety that miraculously manages to capture our abundant sunshine in its perfumed fruit and flavours. Named for the Du Preez family matriarch, this elegant, balanced wine is both graceful and vibrant, a fitting tribute to Cecily.

GROOT CONSTANTIA (2021)

This luscious, full-bodied 2021 Chardonnay from Constantia imparts a more subtle oak flavour offering appealing aromas of ripe peach, pear, apricot and lemon zest.

BUITENVERWACHTING (2023)

A full bodied Chardonnay with zesty minerality. The wine spends 10 months in light French oak barrels to focus on the fruits characteristics with a lighter oak flavour coming through.

CONSTANTIA GLEN “TWO” (2023)

R450

A rich and concentrated blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon, this barrel fermented wine combines oak and tropical fruit flavours with a well-integrated minerality. An elegant wine with exceptional balance and length and fantastic ageing potential.

WADE BALES “CONSTANTIA WHITE” (2023)

R320

The region enjoys a maritime climate on the slopes of Table Mountain, cooled by sea breezes from False Bay and differing altitudes. Given the prime unique position of the area, the closely knit group of winemakers, have honed an unique style of wine which can be considered a world-class benchmark.

BUITENVERWACHTING “BUITEN BLANC”

R170 R75

This full bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend offers a variation of fruit characters including ripe gooseberry, green peppers, green melon and hints of tropical fruit.

CONSTANTIA ROYALE “THE DON” (2023)

R380

The Sauvignon Blanc comes from a small portion of our only East facing block, grown in decomposed granite and clay soil, which produces a linear style of wine tasting primarily of black currant leaf, elderflower and grapefruit. The Semillon, grown on rich shale soils and left till late in the season to maximise the ripeness, adds a rich mouthfeel to the wine, and flavours of white peach.

This rich, full-flavoured dry rosé is made from all five Bordeaux red grape varieties grown on the estate and offers blissful enjoyment on a warm summer's day.

BEAU CONSTANTIA “PAS DE NOM PINK” (2024)

Pas de Nom meaning Without Name is something so sublime that it could only be inspired by an individual of character, strength and temerity, Japie Bronn. It boasts upfront red berry fruit and sweet flowers with undertones of ripe melon. Flavours from the nose follow onto a palate with great texture and mouthfeel.

Delicate blush tones and lively bubbles carry notes of wild strawberry, watermelon, and rose petal. Fresh, bright, and effortlessly charming – a sparkling made for joyful moments and easy enjoyment.

KLEIN CONSTANTIA “VIN D CONSTANCE” (2021)	R1900
Bright light gold in appearance. The nose is layered with aromas of apricots, sandalwood spice & Seville marmalade. A crisp acidity and salinity, with flavours by flavours of nutmeg, citrus, jasmine flower and rose water.	
HIGH CONSTANTIA “HUIS IN BOS” (2016)	R490 R100
Aromatic on the nose, featuring notes of orange blossom, rose petals, apricot and honeyed citrus peel. With a palette providing lush richness balanced by a fresh acidity. Flavours of white peach, golden raisin and lemon zest unfold in layers, leading to a long finish.	
BUITENVERWACHTING “1769” (2022)	R490
Named after the year the first vineyard was planted in the region, 1769 is a 100% muscat de frontignon dessert wine that boasts the history of dessert wine in the Constantia Valley. This classical Constantia Dessert wine offers ripe apricot, melon, fynbos, almond and apple like characters.	
GROOT CONSTANTIA “GRAND CONSTANCE” (2020)	R1700
A touch of red muscat gives the Grand Constance a bright amber colour. The nose shows intense flavours of orange zest, dried apricots, and mango with hints of oak spice.	



CAPE BORDEAUX BLENDS

Cape Bordeaux Red Blends are South African wines that take their origins from the classic red blends of Bordeaux in France, using grapes like Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot. These blends are characterized by their elegant structure, complex fruit flavours and aging potential, offering a South African take on a world-renowned style.

VELD&VINE “RESERVE” (2020)

R300 R110

A unicity of the Cape, the Veld & Vine reserve was grown and vinified at Constantia Glen, a Malbec forward Cape Bordeaux blend, proffering flavours of red fruit, an underlying mocha palette and a light smokiness, leading to a lingering crisp finish. Made specifically for Veld & Vine.

CONSTANTIA GLEN “THREE” (2022)

R490

A classic Constantia blend of the three most revered Bordeaux varieties - Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. A cool maritime climate and strict crop control results in perfectly ripened grapes that are hand harvested, meticulously sorted and batch vinified.

CONSTANTIA GLEN “FIVE” (2022)

R1100

A classic Constantia blend of the five archetypal Bordeaux varieties - Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot. A cool maritime climate and strict crop control results in perfectly ripened grapes that are hand harvested, meticulously sorted and batch vinified.

BUITENVERWACHTING “CHRISTINE” (2021) R990

A Bordeaux blend made of majority Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc with little bits of Merlot, Petit Verdot and Malbec. The Christine spends 24 months in new French oak barrels and another 3.5 years in bottles before being released. The Christine boasts savoury and spicey characteristics.

BEAU CONSTANTIA “LUCCA” (2021) R550

The 2021 vintage Lucca is a blend led by 58% Merlot clone MO343 and 42% Cabernet Franc. Spicy and floral of wild rosemary and Fynbos, this wine is a true sensory reflection of vines growing surrounded by the magnificent Cape Floral Kingdom.

WADE BALES “ELUNDA” (2021) R270

This blend of Merlot 73%, Cabernet Sauvignon 16%, Malbec 11% displays blackcurrant and notes of cherry on the nose. This wine offers up a silky texture as well as a fine tannin structure.

HIGH CONSTANTIA “SEBASTIAAN” (2009) R990

The freshness of this particular vintage, the gentle spiciness that is starting to show on the nose and pallet revealig good, sweet tannin, cedar and dark fruit, a nice, soft underbelly, medium bodied, and outstanding concentration and purity.

GROOT CONSTANTIA “LADY OF ABUNDANCE” R350
(2021)

The blend shows ripe black fruit, with mocha chocolate and a touch of vanilla and wood spice on the nose. The black fruit follows on the palate, the wine shows soft tannins and great length.

MERLOT

STEENBERG (2021) R320 R125

Elegant with soft dark fruit and characteristic notes of plum, liquorice, and mulberry with a lively edge. The nose offers cedarwood and lavender, while the broody and deep palate reveals raspberry preserve.

EAGLES NEST (2020) R350

Meticulous attention in the vineyard and cellar combine to produce a wine of bright ruby colour, textured fruit purity and tantalisingly firm yet moreish tannins. Flavours of mulberry, dark chocolate and tobacco adds further complexity.

BEAU CONSTANTIA "STELLA" (2021)

Derived directly from Latin, the word "stella" meaning star, this wine is a fitting tribute to our deceased mother who will remain a guide and shining light in the Du Preez family as we try to emulate her joie de vivre.

EAGLES NEST (2022)

R320 R120

Perfume and floral aromas combine harmoniously with red cherry and spice on the nose. These flavours gracefully carry through to a savoury, spicy palate, with aromas of star anise and cloves.

HIGH CONSTANTIA (2021)

R1250

The aromas dance from the glass, captivating the senses with a bouquet that is both vibrant and complex. On the palette, it reveals its full bodied character, with notes of juicy blackberry and plum that take centre stage, supported by hints of dark chocolate and espresso.

EAGLES NEST RESERVE (2022)

R600

The aromas dance from the glass, captivating the senses with a bouquet that is both vibrant and complex. On the palette, it reveals its full bodied character, with notes of juicy blackberry and plum that take centre stage, supported by hints of dark chocolate and espresso.

This Pinot noir is the first official release since our 1988 Vintage. This beautifully voluptuous, and elegant Pinot, offers a combination of flavours like fresh red berries, as well savoury spiciness on the finish. Good to drink now, or to put away for another day.

CABERNET FRANC

HIGH CONSTANTIA (2016)

R790

Matured in 300L French Oak, new and second fill barrels. Exhibits typical earthiness and fynbos herbaceousness. It is rich and complex, medium-bodied. Lingering fruit marries with oak and medium tannins on the finish.

PINOTAGE

GROOT CONSTANTIA (2021)

R550 R200

This Pinotage displays generous flavours of ripe red fruit like strawberries and cherries, with subtle hints of dark chocolate and toasted oak on the nose.
